

Wedding Gown Packing Instructions

- 1. Lay two sheets of paper on the bottom of the box.
- 2. Place two sheets of paper on each 4 sides of the box, ensuring the paper hangs over the edge of the sides.
- 3. Lay the gown face down on a wide flat surface such as a double bed, or on a sheet on the floor.
- 4. Place sheets of tissue paper down the centre line of the back of the skirt. Should be about 3 sheets at maximum.
- 5. Fold over one side of skirt to line up with the center back.
- 6. Place a sheet of tissue paper on the fabric.
- 7. Fold over other side of skirt to line up with the center back, laying a piece of tissue paper over the fabric.
- 8. Keep folding towards the middle until the folded gowns width is approx the width of a keyboard.
- 9. Fold the bodice back over the top of the skirt, so that the bodice is facing up.
- 10. Fold any remaining train under the skirt.
- 11. Place the gown into the box to check if it fits.
- 12. Use whatever paper you have left to place over the top of the gown.
- 13. Fold the paper hanging over the edges of the box back onto the gown, ensuring the gown is completely covered with paper.
- 14. If replacing the tissue paper after several years replace with fresh silica gels.
- 15. Ensure that you use a pest prevention method in the area where the gown is stored (under bed/closet), such as moth balls, cedar balls, or orange oil capsules. See Howards Storage World for products. www.hsw.com.au (clothes care page).
